When Should I Keep My Child Home From School?

- Fever of 100 F or higher. Students should return when free of fever for 24 hours WITHOUT fever medication; i.e., no Tylenol or Motrin, for 24 hours.
- Diarrhea or vomiting during the previous 24 hours. Students should return when appetite has returned to normal.
- Rash with a fever.
- Significant cough, sneezing, body aches (or possible symptoms of the Enterovirus D68)
- Illness that prevents a child from participating in activities.
