A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

If you drive your child to school or pick them up after school, I'm sure you have noticed the congested traffic conditions. ABSENCE REMINDER

It is very important that a parent or guardian notifies the office whenever a child is absent. When there is no verification within 3 school days, the absence is considered unexcused. If a student accrues 3 or more unexcused absences, the student is considered to be truant (Ed Code 48260). Please phone the office at (891-3107 x131) any time to report your child's absence. When leaving a message, please state your child's name, your relationship to student, date of absence and reason. Thank you for your help in clearing all student absences! Keep in mind that after 10 excused absences are recorded, a doctor's note is REQUIRED to excuse the absence.
