KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

The date for Kindergarten registration at Citrus is fast approaching. It will be held on Wednesday, December 9th. Registration is from 8:00 AM – 3:30 PM. We will be in the library.

If your child will be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2016, he/she is eligible to begin school in the fall. If they will be 5 years old between September 1st and December 2nd, 2016, they are eligible for Transitional Kindergarten. All you need to do is come to Kindergarten Registration Day and bring his/her birth certificate, immunization records and proof of residence, such as a PG&E or phone bill or rental/lease agreement, etc.

We ask that you leave your children at home, if at all possible. There are several forms that you will need to complete and no child care will be available. Thank you for your cooperation.

Reminder: Citrus is a Latex Free School. Do not bring toys and soft rubber items from home.
