## bullying stops here

On Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, all Citrus School students are encouraged to wear pink as we join other Chico Unified Elementary Schools and stand up to bullying! The tradition of wearing pink to stand up to bullying was established when two high school boys in Nova Scotia purchased pink shirts and handed them out to classmates after they had heard that a new male student at their school had been bullied for wearing a pink shirt. With the theme of Be the One, our students will be asked to pledge to be the one willing to stand up when they see bullying. We know that when one stands up, others will follow. Standing up can mean saying something to those involved in the moment, inviting the targeted student to join in inclusive activities, or reporting to adults at home and school. This is one way we can all impact the kind of school we want to create for one another. We also invite staff and family members to join in wearing pink as a sign of standing up to bullying. All students will receive an 'I Stand Up to Bullying' sticker.
