Random Acts Of Kindness

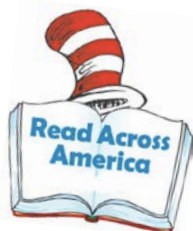
February is kindness month; Citrus is getting involved within the classroom and on the playground. We will be having activities going on throughout the month.
