With the theme of **Be the One**, our students will be asked to pledge to **be the one** willing to stand up when they see bullying. We know that when one stands up, others will follow. Standing up can mean saying something to those involved in the moment, inviting the targeted student to join in inclusive activities, or reporting to adults at home and school. This is one way we can all impact the kind of school we want to create for one another. We also invite staff and family members to join in wearing pink as a sign of standing up to bullying. All students will receive an **'I Stand Up to Bullying'** sticker.
